## Transition from DUNS # to Unique Entity ID (UEI) on 4 April 2022

Dear Valued Northrop Grumman Supplier,

As of April 2022, the United States Government (USG) will stop using the Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS) assigned by the third-party website Dun & Bradstreet to uniquely identify entities. Instead, USG prime contractors and sub-tier suppliers will use a Unique Entity ID (UEI) generated at <u>SAM.gov</u>.

**Don't wait until the last minute!** All suppliers must get their UEI at <u>SAM.gov</u> now. Suppliers do not have to go through the full registration process to obtain the UEI. Establishing a UEI will ensure accurate reporting in <u>FSRS.gov</u>.

Keep in mind that prior to April 4, 2022, the authoritative unique entity identifier to use for subaward reporting is the DUNS Number. *On and after April 4, 2022*, the authoritative unique entity identifier for subaward reporting will be the UEI.

Please ensure future quotes and proposals to Northrop Grumman include your company's UEI.
